Parashat MATTOT-MAS'El... PARASHAT MATTOT opens with a discussion of the binding nature of vows. The Torah teaches us that words

should not be taken lightly and that all vows made in the name of G-d must be fulfilled. In PARASHAT MAS'EI, Israel's sojourn in the wilderness was more than a physical journey. When the children of Israel crossed the Reed Sea, they embarked upon an odyssey which involved an inner soul journey as well as a trip towards Canaan. Forty years of wandering in the wilderness allowed the community of Israel to rediscover its true identity. In a sense, that journey is symbolic of each person's journey through life. All of us begin as little more than slaves subject to the forces of nature and society that surround us. When we end our journey we should be independent and self-reliant human beings who have discovered our true selves.

It is obscene and a lie to continue to mourn for a building. The fact that Tish'ah Be'Av does not focus solely on one event (cf. Mishnah Ta'anit 4:6) but even more so makes the most recent communal tragedy central to the day's observance - means that the observances of self-denial must lead to teshuvah. For our generation that would be the Holocaust, and again not to wallow in misery - but as Isaiah teaches us "חַרְצָבוֹת רֶשָׁע פַּתַּח" (58:6), the mourning that one experiences on a fast day is to make us alert, to think about how many things we could have averted and to gain the resolve to act differently and more wisely the next time.
