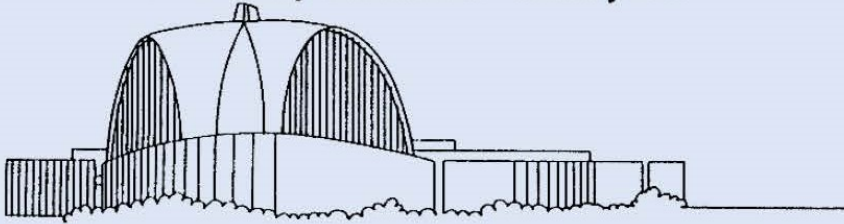

Parashat NASO... is the longest parashah in the entire Torah. The Hebrew name of the portion connects to its four

themes. Naso means 'to count'. First, the reading continues the accounting of the tribe of Levi. The second portion deals with trust and doubt in marriage, which is called Nisu'in (from a root similar to 'Naso'). The third describes the laws of the Nazirite - one who devotes him/herself to G-d through ascetic practices. A final section describes the special sacrifices of the Nisi'im (the princes) of the tribes of Israel.

Reading of Megillat Ruth – Part 2

Seven weeks after Passover there is the holiday known simply by the Hebrew word for “weeks” which is Shavu’ot. This holiday is also known as *Zeman Matan Torah*, or “Festival of Giving the Torah,” or *Hag Ha-Bikkurim* the “Festival of the First Fruits”.

Zeman Matan Torah – According to the Sages, the Torah, the most important book, was given to us on Shavu’ot. It tells the story of Israel’s covenant with G-d over countless generations from Adam and Eve through the reconstruction of the community in the land of Israel after generations of slavery in Egypt. It is our ancient spiritual heritage and contains the guidelines for living a life of righteousness. The Ten Commandments - the core of the covenant given at Mount Sinai - is the centerpiece of our reading from the Torah scroll on the first day of the Shavu’ot festival.

Hag Ha-Bikkurim – refers to the agricultural aspect of the holyday; in the modern period, synagogues and homes are decorated with greenery and flowers.

The biblical story of Ruth the Moabite is also read during the festival. The setting of this story takes place in the spring during the barley and wheat harvests. Its central character is a righteous woman who converts to Judaism and embraces the covenant of Torah. Sephardic Jews read a poetic *ketubah* (marriage contract) between G-d and Israel. In it the Torah is compared to a bride, and Israel to the groom who comes forward to accept her.
