Parashat **HUKKAT...** In this week's parashah, once again, the people complain about their

life in the desert. Before Moses hits the rock, he reprimands them, saying "Hear now, you rebels: from this rock shall we bring forth water for you?!" (Numbers 20:10) Moses, who had previously been described as the 'most humble man on the face of the earth' (Numbers 12:3), seems to explode in anger. According to several commentators, including Maimonides, it was because of this outburst that Moses was punished and not allowed to lead the Israelites into the Promised Land.


