# PLEASE SUPPORT 'Our Children Our War'

Dozens of children now ages 1 - 26 lost both their parents in the brutal attacks on Oct 7th and are orphans.

This tragic and unprecedented phenomenon is an issue that needs to be dealt with comprehensively beyond the limited resources of the Israeli government.

These orphaned children are experiencing unique loss and grief in several aspects:

Losing both parents, brothers, sisters, and extended family, all at once.

Losing their homes and belongings. Losing pets.

Losing their communities and friends.

In most cases, the orphans experienced the atrocities firsthand.

Our Children Our War (OCOW) also supports the children of parents who were kidnapped to Gaza until they are released from captivity.

OCOW is run and managed almost exclusively by volunteers including psychiatrists, social workers, and education, finance and law professionals.

Through the family relationship management system, OCOW provides each orphan with permanent support for the long term, and matches solutions to individual needs. Their job is not only to write a check for immediate assistance of supplies, funds, clothes and hobbies, but to accompany the children, locate and answer their needs for years to come: from psychological treatments through educational support, to accompaniment during army recruitment & military service, to university, and referrals to career paths - everything to put them on a safe path to a good life and allow them a choice so that this disaster will not be what defines them in the future.

Funds are sent to OCOW via the Merit Spread Foundation - a donor fund registered and regulated in the USA as a 503(c)(3) non-profit, and in Israel as a public benefit (46 tax benefit/non-profit) company. The foundation's management is based on a long-term volunteering commitment; NO Salaries will be charged for the main team, most positions are covered fully by volunteers. OCOW makes sure that all donations reach the orphans without any overhead costs. OCOW is advised by Meitar Law Firm (Israel) and Sewkis Law Firm (USA), as well as by Ernst & Young Israel.
